Conflict Management Style Test

Description:

A 42-item test assessing conflict management styles. Seven styles are assessed. A total of 7 general scores and 49 sub-scores are reported. Each style includes a general score and a sub-score for each sphere of his/her social life (simple and complex social interactions, romantic relationships and work/school) and for each type of situation, based on its social significance (high, medium, and low-charge situations). A pre-dominant style is identified for each sphere and type of situation. The higher the score, the closer the match between the test-taker's natural reaction and the clear-cut conflict style.

Conflict management styles:

- 1. <u>Accommodating style</u>: a style whereby one tends to abandon his/her own interests in order to make way for the interests of others.
- 2. Avoidant style: a style whereby one tends to steer clear of conflict.
- 3. <u>Competitive style</u>: a style whereby one tends to stand up for his/her rights, defend a position that s/he firmly believes is correct, or simply push to win.
- 4. <u>Compromising style:</u> a style whereby one tends to look beyond his/her immediate interests and often opts for seeking solutions that will benefit both parties.
- 5. <u>Dominating style</u>: a style whereby one is extremely assertive and turns a blind eye to the perspectives and opinions of the other party.
- 6. <u>Passive aggressive style</u>: a style whereby one tends to avoid the conflict itself by not making his/her perspective, opinions, needs, desires, or goals known, or not addressing the issue directly. Instead, the passive aggressive hides his/her true feelings and allows the resentment and discontent to come out in other ways.
- 7. <u>Transcendent style</u>: a style whereby one tends to transcend conflict.

Social life spheres:

- 1. <u>Simple Social Sphere</u>: Your simple social sphere is composed of one-time interactions, with such people as store clerks, receptionists, and passers-by. These are individuals with whom you have no social history, but interact with due to circumstance. Your lives are not intertwined you are simply acquaintances on life's path.
- 2. <u>Complex Social Sphere</u>: Your complex social sphere is composed of friends and family. These relationships are ongoing, be it over a lifetime or over a set period of time. The complex social sphere is comprised of individuals with whom you have a social history, with whom your life is intertwined. These are the people you care about personally, who mean something to you on an emotional level.
- 3. Romantic Relationship Sphere: Your romantic sphere involves your current romantic relationships. It is the sphere of life in which emotions tend to be strongest. Your romantic sphere does not include past lovers it is focused on those you have romantic feelings for at the present time.
- 4. <u>Work/School Sphere</u>: Your work/school sphere is the place you do your job, it is the part of your life that you depend on for income, stability, achievement and purpose. Your relationships with coworkers and colleagues may be friendly and casual or formal and business-like.

Social significance of situation:

- 1. <u>High charge situations</u>: Situations in which you feel you have a lot at stake. These situations have a high emotional charge and are deemed very important. You tend to have a vested interest in any highly charged situation and feel that its outcome will make a significant difference somehow
- 2. <u>Moderately charged situations</u>: Situations in which you have a reasonable amount of interest. These situations are not life altering nor are they completely without meaning in your life. The outcome of a moderately charged situation is not benign it is significant and your reaction can make a difference in your day-to-day affairs.
- 3. <u>Low charge situations</u>: Situations in which you have very little at stake. You are not emotionally affected or attached to this situation, and you have little vested interest. The outcome of a low charge situation will make little difference to you.





Criterion and Construct Validity

Statistically significant differences in conflict style scores were found among groups depending on self-reported typical reaction to conflict, typical conflict outcome, self-esteem, ability to stand up for oneself, and age group. The group differences were observed in the general score, each social sphere (simple, complex, romantic, work), and each degree of personal significance of the conflict (high-charge, moderate-charge, and low-charge situations). The effects were significant and robust for all conflict styles, with a few exceptions listed below. See Annexes 2-8 for ANOVA tables and annexes 9-13 for tables showing homogeneous subsets.

Exceptions:

- a) Transcendent style in general score and moderate-charge situations: various age groups were not significantly different from each other.
- Competitive style scores in simple social sphere: various age groups were not significantly different from each other.
- c) Transcendent style scores in general score, romantic sphere, work sphere and both low charge and moderate charge situations: various levels of self-esteem were not significantly different from each other.
- d) Competitive style scores in complex social sphere, romantic sphere, and high charge situations: various levels of self-esteem were not significantly different from each other.
- e) Transcendent style in general score, complex social sphere, romantic sphere, work sphere, and both low-charge and moderate charge situations: ability to stand up for oneself were not significantly different from each other.
- f) Accommodating style in simple social sphere and moderate charge situations: various age groups were not significantly different from each other.

Gender Differences

Several statistically significant gender differences were identified. However, the mean differences are not always theoretically significant. Only mean differences of at least 1 point are reported here:

- ?? Women scored significantly higher than men in avoidant style with respect to the simple social sphere, the work/school sphere. Women also scored significantly higher than men in moderately charged situations.
- ?? Women scored significantly higher than men in compromising style on the general score and in all spheres. Women also scored significantly higher than men no matter what the social significance of the situation (high to low charge situations).
- ?? Women scored significantly higher than men in passive-aggressive style with respect to the romantic sphere.
- ?? Men scored significantly higher than women in accommodating style with respect to the romantic sphere.
- ?? Men scored significantly higher than women in avoidant style with respect to the romantic sphere.
- ?? Men scored significantly higher than women in competitive style on the general score and in the complex social sphere and the work/school sphere. Men also scores significantly higher then women in competitive style in both high-charged and low-charged situations.
- ?? Men scored significantly higher than women in dominating style on the general score and in all spheres (simple social, complex social, work/school), except the romantic sphere. Men also scored significantly higher than women no matter what the social significance of the situation (high to low charge situations).
- ?? Men scored significantly higher than women in transcendent style on the general score and in all spheres (complex social, romantic, work/school), except the simple social sphere. Men also scored significantly higher than women in both highly and moderately charged situations.
